





# Children's Message, then Sunday School

**Lesson** Genesis 33:1-11

Jacob looked up and there was Esau, coming with his four hundred men; so he divided the children among Leah, Rachel and the two female servants. He put the female servants and their children in front, Leah and her children next, and Rachel and Joseph in the rear. Jacob went on ahead and bowed down to the




Gathered into one by the Holy Spirit, let us pray as Jesus taught us:






