## **Gospel Acclamation**




The gospel according to Matthew, the 18th chapter. Glory to you, O Lord.

But that same slave, as he went out, came upon one of his fellow slaves who owed him a hundred denarii, and seizing him by the throat said, 'Pay what you owe.' 

Allow us to grow from our mistakes without judgment






