### MICHELLE'S GRANTS UPDATE

Gratitude and Grief, Hope and Loss: Celebrating Ministries at Bethel and BOLD

While Bethel was celebrating 125 years of being an organized congregation, our ministry partner Bread of Life Deaf Lutheran Church (BOLD) was celebrating 68 years in their building on 38th Ave. S. in Minneapolis. Both of these celebrations drew on the foundational history of the communities to ground and root them in hope for their future ministries.

BOLD was celebrating that a Deaf-owned and operated congregation built a building in a time when ASL was a hidden language and when Deaf identity was not celebrated. BOLD used its building well since it was built in 1956, and over the course of the past two years came to the decision that it is time to let go of the building in order to keep walking in faith and hope for what the Holy Spirit will bring to them in the future. The BOLD Community is using a sign like a strong tree to indicate that their future is indeed strong.

Both Bethel and BOLD engaged in reflections and gratitude for the gifts that have been in the communities' histories, and both communities have set intentions to be open to the gifts that will come to each community. In the process for each celebration, Bethel and BOLD allowed space for all of the feelings that come up in these celebrations, so that in the end fear and doubt will not prevent us from recognizing the gifts that show up for us. Because gifts from the Holy Spirit will continue to show up!

hank you all for making the 125th Anniversary joyful and exciting. Thank you for making and listening to the music with your whole hearts. We were blessed to have former singers and handbell ringers join us for festival choirs, and to have a few who joined for the first time.

What is a choir? Whether singers or handbell ringers, we are a group of people who make music together. In American English, we speak of the choir as a single entity using singular verbs: the choir is, does, sings, plays, etc. This is important, because the individuals must act in unity to make music.

A choir is also a group of individuals. In British English, we would speak of them as a collection of people using plural verbs: the choir are, do, sing, play. I highlight this sense of Bethel's choirs to show each person's importance in making up the group. We need individuals to form the group.

I invite you to prayerfully consider joining one of these groups - to lend your voice or hands to carry God's Word to the congregation, and carry our prayers to God in worship. You need not be an experienced musician or



know how to read music. That is something we all continue to learn.
