

### ELLIE'S GRANTS UPDATE

#### Hello Everyone,

appy November! I hope the chilly, cozy weather is treating you well, and that you're able to take the opportunity the next few weeks to show gratitude for the good things in life, in spite of the bad. I know that at Bethel, we certainly have plenty to be thankful for. Have you noticed the sounds of hammering from approx. 10 - 5 pm? I personally find it hard to ignore, as someone who lives within earshot of the church, but it is music to my ears, knowing we are finally getting our new roof installed!

And with the roof project moving forward, we need your help more than ever to spread the word about our *Raise* the Roof! fundraiser. I hope that by now you've heard talk of our Give to the Max Day fundraising campaign, but did you know that we can start taking donations as early as

November 1st? Early donations will be eligible to win additional prizes towards Bethel's roof fund-a daily chance for Bethel to win an extra \$500 gift from GiveMN. But the real excitement will happen on Give to the Max Day itself,

November 20th. Every 15 minutes on GTMD, Bethel has a chance to win a \$1000 prize through GiveMN, with each donation to our Raise the Roof! fundraiser counting as an entry to this raffle. You can learn more about GTMD and these prizes on givemn.org.

We would love to have you all celebrate and fundraise with us on the 20th, so please join us for a Raise the Roof! benefit party that evening from 5-8 pm! All the excitement aside, I think it's important to remember why we are raising this money to begin with. For years now we have made it a priority to cement Bethel as a fixture of the community. We want to be a place where people feel safe and welcome, and free to pursue education, worship, ministry, and outreach in many forms. Replacing the roof is essential to allow everyone, including the congregation itself, to continue using this building that has served us so well for the past 70 years. I'd like to include some testimonials that were shared with me by some of the folks who rely on the use of our space.

"CANMN loves being at Bethel. Very generally, it is a space that is very accessible to our community members that need support. More specifically, we really feel how much Pastor Brenda and Regan believe in our work. It is so refreshing and has not always been the case for us at previous places we have been. Not only are the staff at Bethel accommodating with providing additional refrigeration or storage when we need it, but they are always asking how else they can support our work. We feel at home at Bethel. At home in the physical space and even more so with the people. We could not imagine a better space for us to do our work."

"We joined scouts 4 years ago. My kids love the engagement, activities, and the amazing space we get to do it in. When my oldest went from the troop to the pack, he wanted me to come to the meetings. I sat there, chatted, didn't really do anything...until they recruited me to be a scout leader. Now I engage 20-30 scouts regularly as they work towards becoming adults who lead through the principles of scouting (trustworthy, loyal, helpful, friendly, courteous, kind, obedient, cheerful, thrifty, brave, clean, reverent)."

"Our small group was outgrowing its limited space, and my wife had mentioned Bethel posting a message on Facebook about rentals. I hadn't imagined our humble group could rent such a nice space on a regular basis, but my wife said the message was so friendly and community-focused that she encouraged me to reach out.

Now here we are, 18 months into training at the gym. The staff and leadership have been incredibly accommodating and friendly. I volunteered my time for some tech support help, just as a small way to pay back their support of us. Our group's activity is focused on cultural preservation, not profit. Bethel has been incredibly respectful and supportive in finding ways for us to use their space for regular training and special seminars. I don't know what we'd do without their support!"

# FEASIBILITY UPDATE

Now that the roof is being installed, and the insurance payments have come in, we just need one final push to cover the remaining \$42,671 of our bill. Once again, we would really appreciate you all spreading the word as much as possible. Every bit helps–even just \$25 will cover the cost of 5 shingles for the roof!



I hope to see you all at the party on Nov. 20th, and that you have a lovely start to your holiday season. We at Bethel are very thankful for you all, and all that you do!





# MISSION COUNCIL REPORT


