





Gospel Luke 1:68-79


The Gospel of the Lord according to Luke, the first chapter. **Glory to you, O** Lord.

For as often as we eat this bread and drink this cup, we proclaim the mystery of faith, that **Christ has died. Christ is risen. Christ will come again.** 


#### Lord's Prayer
