GREETINGS FROM YOUR BOARD OF ADMINISTRATORS!

The Board met in December over Zoom on a cold, windy, and snowy night. As usual, there was a lot to celebrate at Bethel - in particular, the successful Raise the Roof fundraiser. Thank you to all who worked hard to make this happen, and who attended and contributed, and thanks especially to the Bethel staff for their amazing efforts! We're also grateful for the overall increase in the use of our building this year -- it's wonderful to feel the energy and see so many neighbors in our space.

This month, again, we checked in on various operational issues - from our insurance coverage, to the various legal arrangements related to the cell phone tower, to budget projections for next year, to the snow clearing plan that's working well so far this year. Staff are in the process of renewing leases and discussing upcoming space needs with the partner organizations who rent space at Bethel.

Looking ahead to our annual congregational meeting on March 1, we are looking for new leaders willing to serve on the board (at least two seats will be open), and in other leadership roles throughout our church community, for new terms that begin in mid-2026. In addition to ongoing stewardship of our spaces, resources, and ministry, next year's board will continue to work closely with the Feasibility Study Team, Mission Council, and other leaders to help discern the best next steps for right-sizing our space and building new partnerships.

ELLIE'S GRANTS UPDATE

HAPPY JANUARY AND HAPPY 2026!

In my last article, I extended my general thanks for everyone's efforts towards the Raise the Roof fundraising campaign, even though Give to the Max Day and the Raise the Roof party hadn't happened yet. Now that I'm writing this in December, I want to give everyone a massive THANK YOU in light of the results of our campaign! Thanks to all of your help, we were able to raise over \$20,000 towards the repair of our roof, which may be our most successful Give to the Max Day ever! We couldn't have done it without you, so thank you to everyone who donated, spread the word about the fundraiser, and/or attended the party. Given the success of this year's fundraiser, we definitely plan to host a similar event next fall, so please let us know if you have any ideas of fundraising goals we might focus on, or ways to make our Give to the Max Day 2026 event even better.

Speaking of events, I want to give an update about a grant we received towards the end of 2025. You may remember the Paint-n-Sip event we hosted last September; this was made possible with a \$750 mini-grant awarded by Fairview Health, to be used towards community health and connectedness. I'm

pleased to announce that we were awarded the same grant again for 2026, and this time we plan to use it towards a blood drive and neighborhood feast this upcoming May or June. Please keep an eye out for more information about the blood drive in the near future, and let me know if you have an idea for a snappy/alliterative title before we roll out the marketing campaign!

Lastly, I'd like to remind everyone that Thrivent Members are eligible to apply for new Action Team Grants at the start of 2026, and Associate Members are eligible to reapply one calendar year from their last grant. Please reach out to us in the office if you'd like to help out with a project and claim your \$250 worth of funding from Thrivent. We have a list of upcoming events and funding needs for 2026, so there's plenty to choose from, whether you'd like to sponsor food for a Community Fun Night, activities for summer camp, or something else. Our goal for the year is \$10,000 worth of grants, or 40 grants total, so please reach out to sign up soon!

MISSION COUNCIL REPORT

By the time you read this, it will be 2026. I wish everyone a joyous and blessed new year! Something new this year, Bethel has joined the Mental Health Connect program (<https://www.mhconnect.org/>), which is housed at Bethlehem Lutheran in South Minneapolis. Bethel's congregation members are now eligible to attend their monthly educational meetings. I attended November's workshop, "Skills for Disagreeing Better." It was about being able to converse with those who have different political views, and it was very, very good. Their next event is "A Layperson's Guide to Understanding Trauma Disorders" on Tuesday, January 13, 2026, at 7:00 PM via Zoom. Please let me know if you are interested, and I can send you the link to register. I have been onboarded as a Mental Health Connect Ambassador; others from our congregation are eligible to do the same. Please let me know if that would be something that would interest you.

Bethel members will be receiving a monthly email from me about their events and resources available to help those in need.

At our December meeting, the Mission Council decided that the February 12 Community Fun Night will feature board games, with a meal of chili, salad, and cinnamon rolls. Please mark your calendars for this fun event! We also learned that we already have 25 people registered to attend Family Camp at the Mt. Olivet Retreat Center. They have a wonderful space with beautiful winter nature views, great food, a rec center and a swimming pool.
